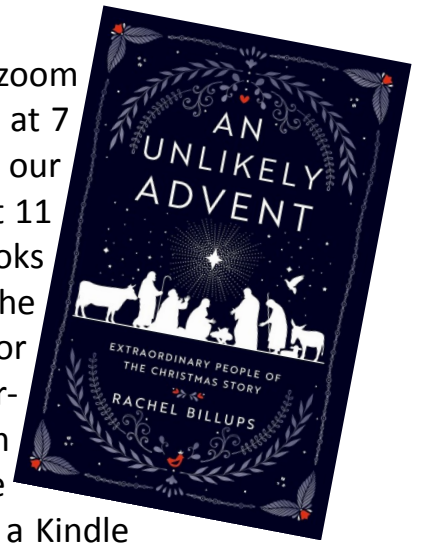


This week at FPC

This four-week Advent study beginning November 28 focuses on the experiences of four sets of often overlooked characters in the Nativity story. The author, Rachel Billups, guides readers through the themes of hope, love, joy, and peace by sharing the stories of Elizabeth and Zechariah, Herod, the Magi, and the shepherds. Each set of unexpected characters has something to teach about living faithfully on the journey to Christmas. There will be a video accompanying the study each week.

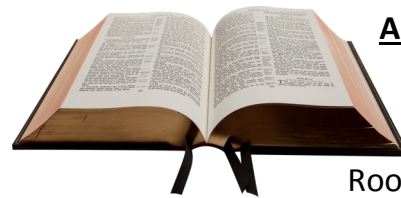
